Reasons For Request

The Defendant respectfully requests that the Court considers and grants his telephonic/video Appearance Request for the following reasons:

1. Defendant is very concerned for his health due to Covid and high

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1. Flu transmission. Transporting the Defendant would jeopardize his health by subjecting him to numerous Correction Officers at various institutions while traveling down to High Desert State Prison, if needed to appear.
2. The Defendant is very concerned for his safety. There have been many stabbings and assaults at High Desert State Prison (The Defendant knows this because the NDOC Director looks down the entire state prison system when it happens. The last being in November). Due to the sensitive nature of the Defendant's case, he would not feel protected nor safe at High Desert State Prison, if needed to appear.
3. Inmate Correctional Center has all the needed equipment for telephonic and video court appearances.
4. It is an unnecessary cost to have the NDOC and State to produce the Defendant, if needed to appear, when the equipment is available for him to be present by telephonic or video.

The Defendant, who is subject to this request, has executed the consent on the next page and agrees to be bound by oath given by the Court Clerk, Eighth Judicial District Court and to be subject to the jurisdiction of this Court for purposes related to his Motion To Correct Illegal Sentence and Supporting Memorandum and any testimony he deposes.

Any objection to this request must be made in writing within two (2) judicial days of service of this request.
